HANDY PERSON ADAPTATION SERVICE (HPAS)

Adaptation jobs

Are jobs such as fitting grab rails, stair rails, half-steps and exterior hand rails which help you move around your home and stay steady on your feet, You can have up to £1000 worth of adaptations supplied and fitted in a single job for the cost of £15

Handy person jobs

The other type of jobs are referred to as handy person jobs. There is a flat rate of £15 to the customer for the labour and you will be limited to up to four hours work. You will need to pay for the materials used, but the trader will be able to buy these on your behalf at the beginning of the job if you are unable to buy them yourself.

- The Service User MUST live within Nottinghamshire (excluding Nottingham city).

- The Service User MUST be over the age of 60 OR have a disability. The scheme can only be accessed once within a 3 month period, please see below for exceptions:
- Adaptation to Adaptation – No restriction
- Adaptation to Handypersons – 3 months from last adaptation
- Handypersons to Handypersons – 3 months from last handypersons
- Handypersons to Adaptations – No restriction
- Adaptations - there is no longer a charge for adaptations.
- Handypersons – there is a charge of £15 which must be paid to the trader when the work is carried out AND the service user must also pay for the cost of materials.
- Adaptations and handypersons - If the request is for both the cost would be 1 x £15 AND the cost of materials.

The following can be provided under the adaptation scheme.

- External Hand Rails
- External Grab Rails
- Internal Grab Rails
- Second Stair Rail (wooden mop stick rail- will be supplied ready for use but will not be painted or varnished- first stair rails are the responsibility of the home owner but can be requested as handy persons works if required)
- Half Steps

Grab rails/rails will no longer be fitted to hollow walls under the HPAS scheme.
Grab rails provided are basic white and brown only

FREE CONCESSIONARY TRAVEL SCHEME

Who is eligible?

The scheme no longer provides a free pass automatically at the age of 60. Instead, the qualifying age is now linked to the state pension age. To see when you will qualify for a free pass on age grounds, have a look on www.gov.uk/calculate-state-pension

You are an eligible disabled person if you:

- are blind or partially sighted
- are profoundly or severely deaf
- are without speech
- have a disability, or have suffered an injury, which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on your ability to walk
- do not have arms or have long term loss of the use of both arms
- have a learning disability - a state of arrested or incomplete development of mind which includes significant impairment of intelligence and social functioning, or
- would have an application to drive a motor vehicle refused due to your disability.

When can you use your pass?

The National Concessionary Pass allows you to enjoy free off-peak travel on local buses anywhere in England. The national free entitlement operates between 9:30am and 11:00pm Monday to Friday and all day at weekends and on public holidays.

How do you apply for your travel pass and how much does it cost?

The concessionary travel passes are initially free of charge, however if you lose your pass a fee may be charged for the replacement.

Physical including hitting, slapping, punching, kicking or the misuse of medication on someone.

Sexual including rape or sexual assault acts which the person has not consented to. It may be non-contact such as teasing or being photographed.

Psychological including threats, humiliating someone, controlling or intimidating.

Financial including stealing or tricking the person out of money or material possessions like their house or jewellery.

Discriminatory including racist, sexist, that is based on a person's disability and other forms of harassment.

Neglect is also a form of abuse - leaving someone without food or heating, refusing to take care of personal needs and failing to provide access to appropriate health and social care may all be forms of neglect.

SOCIAL PRESCRIBING SERVICE

The aim of this service is about linking people to activities in the community that promotes independence and wellbeing. It is about connecting people to non-medical sources of support.

How to Access the Service/What the Service Provides

Patients can be referred into the service via their GP or Community Nursing Service. The patient will then receive a visit from a Voluntary and Community Services (VCS) Advisor to discuss voluntary or community services that could improve the patient's health and wellbeing. The service is available for a maximum of 12 weeks. The Advisor can help patients to:-

- Access specific support groups
- Attend local community social groups
- Access benefits, debt and welfare rights advice
- Address isolation issues
- Access services for carer/s
- Create a plan of action

- Improve health and wellbeing and independence
- Access information and advice on a wide range of services
- Access other services eg. community transport

At the end of the 12 week intervention, the Advisor will arrange to meet the patient and discuss next steps to enable the patient to continue accessing the support they have received from the voluntary and community sector.

We are also looking for drivers for our Community Car Scheme Plus vehicle. This vehicle has been fully adapted for wheelchair users and offers a door to door service for people of all ages. The vehicle is also able to carry a mobility scooter and up to 3 passengers. It is also fitted with a Turney Seat that comes right out of the car enabling the passenger to sit on and be lifted into the vehicle; this will be particularly helpful for people with limited mobility. We provide all training for this vehicle which will help individuals to travel in safety and comfort to make those important appointments, get to work or simply socialise with friends for an affordable fare.
