

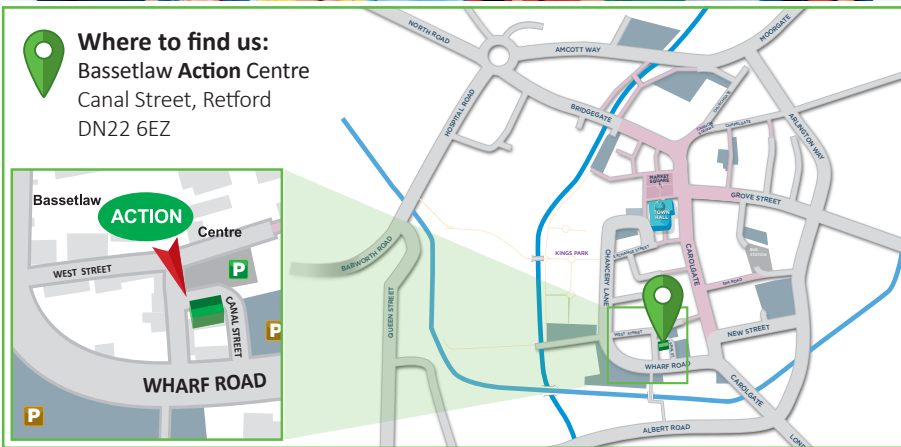
Have You Ever Thought About Volunteering?

Housing Choice

Housing Choice:

This service provides information, advice and support to people in Bassetlaw on housing related issues across all tenure.

Who Is It For?

Our service is aimed at older and vulnerable people, their families and carers, who recognise that they are starting to find things difficult in their own homes and want to consider their options to meet their changing needs. This might include moving to more suitable accommodation such as somewhere smaller, nearer to family and friends or housing specifically for older people such as sheltered housing.

They could also be thinking about making changes to their existing property such as repairs or adaptations.

Our service is also aimed at advice, health and social care workers who support older and vulnerable people.



What Support Is Available?

The Housing Choice Advisor or Caseworker can:

- Provide information, advice or support on a one to one basis.
- Provide support to explore different housing options and help put these changes in place, as appropriate.
- Support in the moving process.
- Provide benefit advice.
- Assist to register for social housing.
- Assist to register with housing associations.
- Provide home visits as appropriate.
- Refer on to other services.
